## GENERAL

### **Introduction**

The IMF NSCC is responsible for and shall approve the following competitions:

- a. National Youth Cup series of competitions (NYC)
- b. National Cup series of competitions (NC)
- c. National K Championships (NKCH)
- d. 30<sup>th</sup> National Championship (NCH)

Unless otherwise specified in this Climbing Manual, each competition shall be held in accordance with IFSC Rules

### **Competition Officials**

The IMF NSCC shall be responsible for nominating the following IMF officials:

- a. Event Delegate (ED)
- b. Jury President (JP)
- c. IMF Judge (IJ)
- d. Chief Route setter (CRS)
- e. Route setter (RS)

The Organiser shall bear the travel and accommodation expenses as well as the honorarium of the IMF Officials.

The Organiser shall be responsible for providing national route setters and judges to support the Route setting and Judging team.

### **Anti-Doping**

The Organisers of NYC, NC, NYCH and NCH shall arrange for anti-doping tests:

- to be carried out in compliance with the national regulations governing international sport
- to be administered as a minimum to the winners of at least six (6) of the Categories held.

### **Medals, and prizes**

The NSCC shall provide the winners' medals in gold, silver, and bronze medals respectively to competitors ranked first, second and third in each category and discipline.

The Organiser should provide gifts to be awarded to competitors ranked first, second and third in each category and discipline.



## SPORT EQUIPMENT

### Wall Specification

All competition walls shall comply with requirements as set out in the [IFSC Venue Description and Walls Requirements and Guidelines](#).

### Boulder Timing System

The Boulder Timing System is a mandatory requirement to host IFSC-Asia Boulder competitions.

As a countdown timer, the Boulder Timing System shows the remaining time within each Observation Period, Preparation Period and Climbing Period in minutes and seconds (i.e. 03:50, 3 minutes and 50 seconds remaining)

### Speed Timing System

The Speed Timing System & Auto Belay is a mandatory requirement to host NC & NCH Speed competitions.

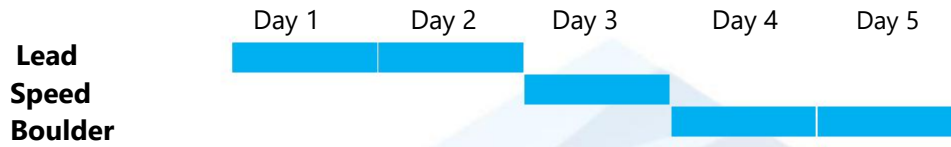


## ASIAN K CHAMPIONSHIP

### Introduction

The IMF will organise the Asian K Championship (AKCH) in November 2026.

The AKCH competition shall be organised over a period of five (5) days:



### Registration & Quota

Each AKCH shall include categories for male and female competitors in the following age groups:

- Under 13: competitors born in 2014 - 2015
- Under 15: competitors born in 2012 - 2013

### Format

AKCH competitions shall be organised in accordance with the relevant IFSC Rules with the following modifications:

The Boulder Final round shall be preceded by a collective observation period of eight (8) minutes. Competitors are free to observe the boulders in any order and duration within this observation period.

### Speed Climbing Wall & Route Specifications

Effective from 2026, the speed climbing wall at AKCH must adhere to the technical standards outlined in IFSC Wall Requirements. A mandatory height of 15 meters is required for the speed wall, and the previously implemented 10-meter route will no longer be utilized. The revised speed route layout for AKCH, including detailed technical specifications, is documented in Annex 1.



## NATIONAL SUB JUNIOR TEAM FOR K CHAMPIONSHIP

**Top 3 Athletes ranked as per the National Rankings 2025 will constitute A-Team** in respective categories. **3** Training Camps will be organised before December 2026 of which 2 camps will be mandatory. In addition, training support system will be provided for the entire year of 2026 through the zones.

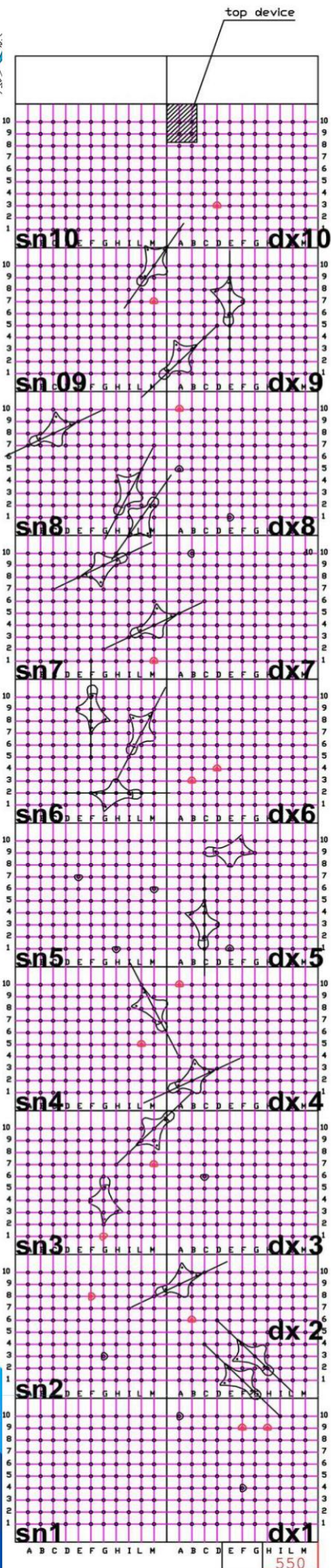
### **Date of the training camp:**

**B-Team** will be selected for participation based on the performances in the Youth Cups & National Cups in 2026. One mandatory training camp will be organized by the NSCC in October 2026. Athlete with Extraordinary performance in any of the cups will be moved to A-Team.

### Registration & Quota for AYCH & AYC

IFSC AYCH (Asian Youth Championship) & YWCH (Youth World Championship) shall include categories for male and female competitors in the following age groups:

- Under 17: competitors born in 2010 – 2011
- Under 19: competitors born in 2008 – 2009

IFSC AYC (Asian Youth Cup) shall include categories for male and female competitors in the following age groups:

- Under 17: competitors born in 2010 - 2011
- Under 15: competitors born in 2012 - 2013

National Youth Cups are being organised to give competition exposure & specifically to eliminate any discrepancies that will arise due to the new age group & categories among U19 & U17 by IFSC & IFSC Asia. competition positions will be added to continuous national ranking to make the final ranking as per disciplines for participation in International Competition for Youth & Kids Championship.

Each **IMF National Youth Cup Series** shall include categories for male and female competitors in the following age groups & will be organised as per relevant IFSC rules.

- Under 19: competitors born in 2008 – 2009
- Under 17: competitors born in 2010 – 2011

### National Ranking system

National Ranking which has been in force since 2025 (As recommended by the Athlete commission and deliberated by the raking sub-Committee and approved by the NSCC and GC), will continue as National Ranking 2026 with the upgraded version after incorporating the feedbacks from athletes, officials and zonal committees. Participation in Asian Championship, Asia Cup, World Cup, World Championship for 2026 will be based on Ranking System 2025. The IMF NSCC Ranking System has been shared & explained below. The ranking system 2026 were open for suggestions from Athletes, officials, Associations and Zonal Committees. Thereafter, the manual has been released.

## IMF CLIMBING MANUAL 2026

### Features:

1. Annual System - 3 top performances of the year out of 3 competitions - at least two has to be from National circuit.
2. International performances include IFSC Asia Cups, Asian Championships, World Cups and World Championship (does not include promotional events)
3. World CLIMBING Performances are graded based on limit caps. The best performances from our country are rewarded with points equivalent to National Podium Finish.
4. Top 5 Athletes considered for National Team based on ranking from 1st Jan until the end of the year
5. In case of speed climbing apart from ranking a minimum qualification time (consistently) of sub 6 seconds for men and sub 9 seconds for women will be enforced for participation in international events for 2026. (Special entry for junior to senior transitional athletes will also be considered without ranking)
6. Ranking points are reset at the onset of a new year.
7. If there's a tie, IFSC rules will be followed to break it - addition of both rank points and average is given to each athlete.
8. Top 5 ranked athletes (CUNR) in the seniors will be granted direct entry in to the 30th National Climbing Championship 2026 in each discipline respectively.
9. Climbers ranked between 6 and 10 in the senior category will earn the zone an additional quota in the 30th National Climbing Championship.
